Research to Practice Gap

- Persistent in special education (Carnine, 1997; Cook & Cook, 2013)
- Students are not receiving the EBPs that are most likely to make a difference (Spencer, Detrich, & Slocum, 2012)
- Particularly troubling in special education (Cook & Cook, 2013; Zigmond & Kloo, 2011)

Evidence-Based Practices

- Practices that have shown to have rigorous positive impacts on the skills of students with disabilities (Cook, 2014; Cook & Cook, 2011; Cook & Cook, 2013)

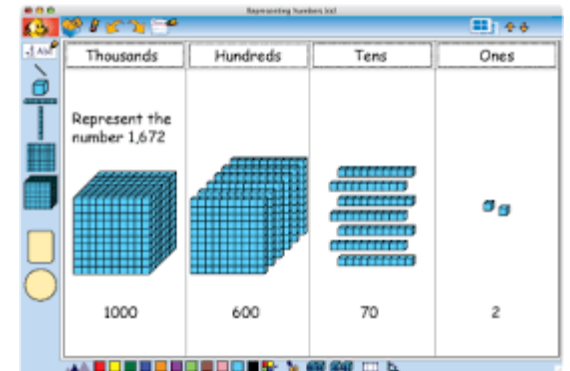
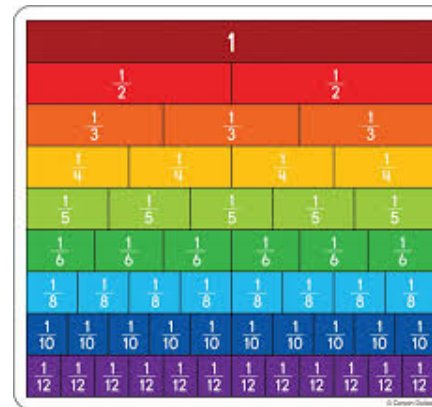
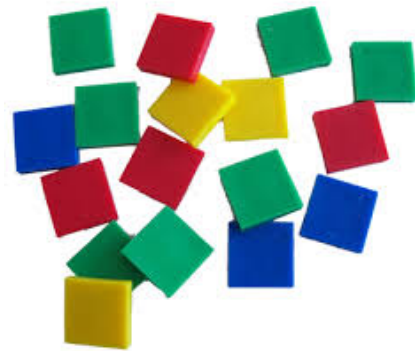

Micro-EBPs

- Typically do not have a prescribed framework
- Require teacher decision making to implement (Torres, Farley, & Cook, 2014)

For example: Using mathematical representations or models on the math outcomes of students with LD or at risk for math difficulties (Jitendra, Nelson, Pulles, Kiss, & Houseworth, 2016)



Micro EBPs

- Teacher awareness of research impacts their ability to implement micro-EBPs and the outcomes they get (Guckert, Mastropieri, & Scruggs, 2016)

Pinterest

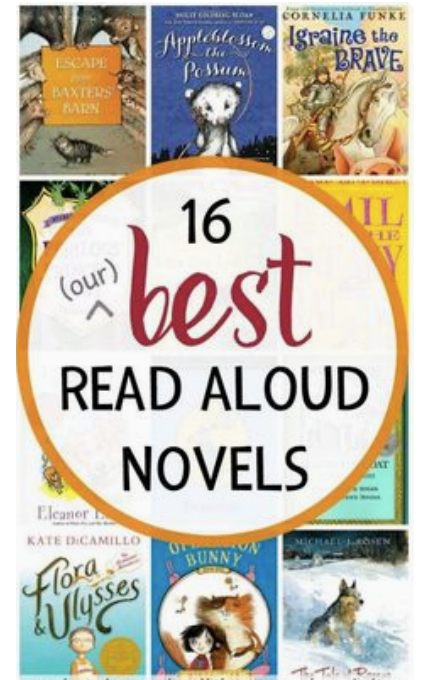
- Teachers are on Pinterest

- 1.3 million education sites and resources were pinned EACH DAY in 2014 (Cummings, 2015)

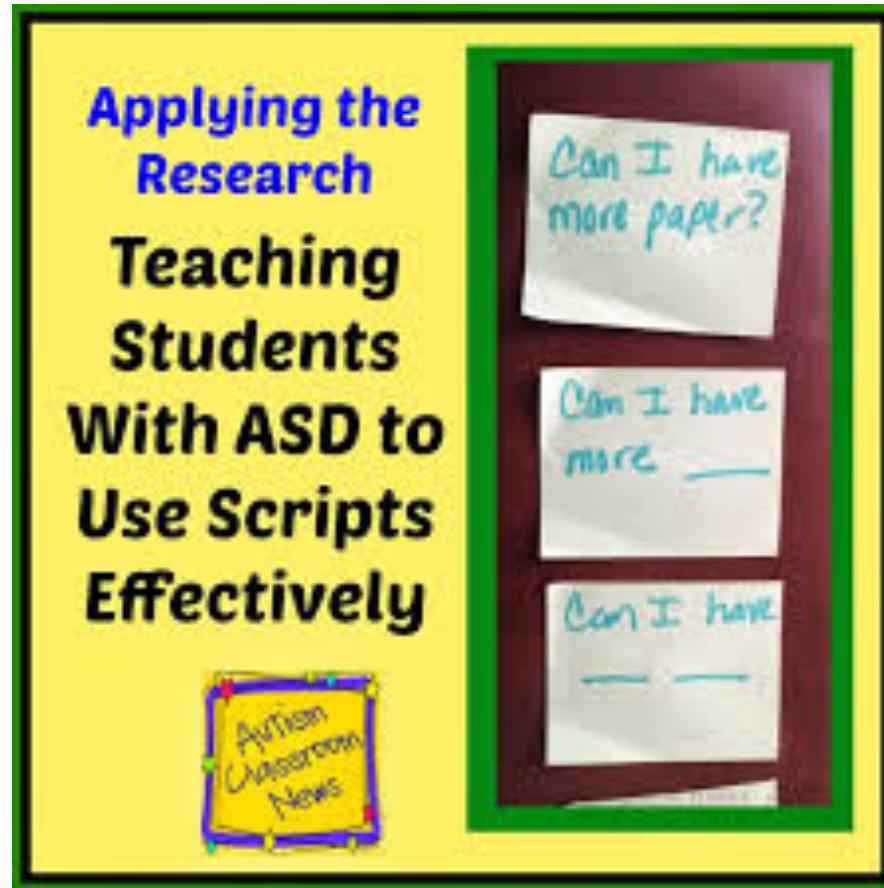


Pinterest

- **The potential of Pinterest:**
- Help bridge the research-to-practice gap in terms of Trustworthiness and Accessibilitiy:
- Teachers trust each other
- Teachers access resources through the internet (Nelson, Leffler, & Hansen, 2009; Jones, 2009)

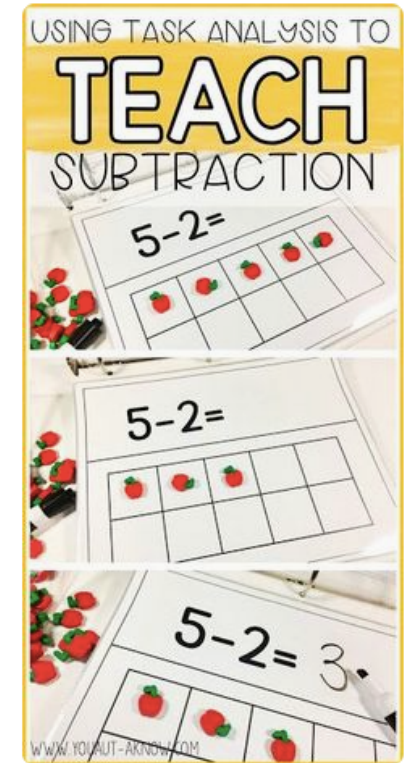

Paragraph shrinking is an activity developed as part of the Peer-Assisted Learning Strategies (PALS). The paragraph shrinking strategy allows each student to take turns reading, pausing, and summarizing the main points of each paragraph. Students provide each other with feedback as a way to monitor comprehension.
