- 2. SUBMISSION: You will send your proposal by email to Program Co-Chair Dr. Ginevra Courtade at acres@lousiville.edu. Please call 502-852-2144 if there is a problem with electronic submission.
- 3. CONFIRMATION: You will receive confirmation via email soon after we receive your proposal.
- 4. DEADLINES: Proposals MUST be submitted **no later than October 15 at midnight.**Late submissions will be considered if program space permits.
- 5. STATUS: You will be notified of the status of your proposal by **December 1.**

SELECTION PROCESS

Each complete proposal will undergo an anonymous review process using these criteria will:

- Is the proposal clear as to what the presenter(s) will provide for the audience?
- Does the proposal lend itself to practical application by others?
- Does the proposal provide an empirical or theoretical base?
- Does the proposal relate to the conference theme?
- Does the topic have appeal to an audience of educators, administrators, related service personnel, teacher trainers, policy makers, and/or parents?
- Does the topic have implications for rural special education?
- Is the proposal well organized: Does the proposal follow the specified format?
